In addition to the General Competition open to any American-made wine, the competition also included a unique *Women Winemaker's Challenge™*, in which wines made exclusively by U.S. women winemakers were judged by our distinguished, all-women panels.

Over 1850 wines were tasted and evaluated by seven panels of judges. Judges were specifically instructed to grant awards only to those bottles that the judges agreed were outstanding.

NWWC™ Award Guide

Bronze	A very good wine to enjoy at home or with friends.
Silver	An excellent wine, one worthy of sharing with friends at a restaurant or at home.
Gold	An outstanding wine; appropriate for special occasions, celebrations, or as a gift. If a red wine, often worthy of cellaring.
Double Gold	All judges unanimously conferred Gold Medal status on the wine.
Gold-Best of Class	A Gold Medal wine and the best wine of all in its class
Sweepstakes	Tasted by all 30 judges and determined the best red, white, sparkling, or dessert wine of the General Competition or the Women Winemaker's Challenge™.
Judges' Choice	Tasted by all 30 judges and acclaimed by all to be worthy of particular commendation. Two Judges' Choice awards were given, one in the General and one in the Women Winemaker's Challenge™, in 2007.
